This is with reference to some reports published in samvada about RWA:

1. **"Tentwala Damages The Main Water Pipe Resident Goes Waterless"**. In this connection we would like to clarify that immediately on receipt of the complaint RWA talked to the senior officer and got the fault rectified with no time.
2. **"Maruti Zen Stolen From (J-129) Lack of Wire Fencing Between Prayag & J-Block is A Big Security Hazard"**. Delegation of ladies met RWA office bearers. The affected resident said that they were having 3 cars and the car without gear lock was stolen whereas RWA has repeatedly been requesting the residents to use gear lock for their cars as a safety measure. There were 2 guards and not one as reported. The guard employed for the Block was absent and on being informed immediately the 2<sup>nd</sup> guard was arranged. Therefore it is wrong to say that only one guard was on duty. So far as the refencing between Prayag and J- Block is concerned, action has already been taken and wire fencing has been done. Refencing has also been done between Gate No. 24 and House No. J-161, which was broken at many places. In this connection we would like to bring to the notice of the residents that the fencing is done every year and it gets broken by the residents. We shall appreciate if the residents staying nearby also take little care to see that this wire fencing is not broken as lot of expenditure is involved on refencing.

We shall appreciate if Samvada counter check with RWA before such one-sided story is published. Some people, just to get noticed, rush to the Media and blame RWA for inaction. RWA is fully aware of its responsibility and the interest of our residents is of

utmost importance. We are grateful for the faith and trust reposed in us and we shall try our best to see that the interest of the residents is fully served.

### **RIGHTS AND DUTIES**

We expect a lot from RWA and are always in search of an opportunity to put blame for any/everything and are very eager to rush to the media to get it published. It is very unfortunate that media too without counter checking with RWA publish such one sided stories. While asking for rights we are also expected to know our duties. We have repeatedly been requesting the non-payers to cooperate and pay their dues so that better facilities could be provided but all our requests have fallen on deaf ears. It is not that they cannot afford to pay this meagre amount of Rs.150/- per month but it is the intention not to pay and enjoy all the facilities at the cost of those who are regular payers. Better facilities could be provided if our non-paying members cooperate. We need to strengthen the security and take adequate measures towards that direction but because of financial strain due to non-paying members this is not possible. Our sector is a porous sector and inspite of best efforts we are not able to do much. We shall therefore request the Members, who, on one pretext or the other, blame RWA, to cooperate and make the non-paying Members cooperate and pay their dues. This is a joint effort as we are all part of the sector and this is our dream to see our sector as one of the Best Sectors in Noida where all our residents coming from different parts of India, belonging to different castes and culture could lead a smooth, peaceful and secured life and have a feeling of brotherhood and communal harmony.

### **SECURITY**

Security is required to be tightened because of the recent happenings; we have been repeatedly requesting our residents to kindly abide by the guidelines periodically circulated in our circulars. Security is a collective responsibility and cannot be effective unless we all co-operate and abide by the following guidelines:

1. Necessary Police verification may be done before you intend to employ any domestic help.
2. Do not let out your premises without satisfying yourselves about the antecedents of the tenants. Insist on Identification documents and send the necessary intimation to the police.
3. Never leave your house unattended. It is seen that generally the thefts take place at such houses. We shall therefore reiterate our request to kindly arrange for personal security guard whenever you plan to go out.
4. Be watchful and report any suspicious activity around you and keep an eye on suspicious looking persons/objects.
5. Use gear lock for your car as it is seen that generally the car without gear lock is the target. Display RWA stickers. Parking may be done in such an away that there is no obstruction on the road for smooth flow of traffic.
6. Vendors have been issued necessary identity cards. Residents are requested not to entertain any person without RWA Identity cards.
7. Hoarding/Banners are not allowed without permission from RWA.
