### **GUEST HOUSES/COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS**

It is very unfortunate that some of the house owners just to earn more money are converting their houses into Guesthouses. 10 to 20 persons are put in the same house without any verification. In this way they are not only putting their neighbours into lot of inconvenience but putting the whole sector into a great security risk. Guesthouses are not allowed inside the sector and as per lease agreement the houses can only be used for purpose for which they are allotted. i.e. for residential purpose only. We would therefore like to warn such persons to desist from such illegal practice and not to use their houses as guest house/commercial activities.

### **A WORD TO DEFAULTERS/NON-PAYERS**

We have been repeatedly requesting the non-paying members to clear their dues but the response is very poor. Since the welfare activities depend only on the collection of the subscription from the members/tenants who are availing of the services we shall request such nonpaying members to kindly clear their dues at the earliest; otherwise RWA will be left with no alternative but to discontinue all the services to such non-paying members. It has come to our notice that the monthly payment is not being paid by all the occupants of the house. i.e. owners

and tenants. It is however clarified that the monthly payment is to be made by the house owner as well as by his tenants separately.
