2. Please inform the Police if you intend to rent out your house and get the necessary verification done.

3. Entertain only those vendors/dhobis who have been duly authorized by the RWA through Identity Cards and do not open main door/gate for unidentified persons.
4. Residents going out of station should not leave their houses unattended and arrange to have a personal guard. In case of difficulty you can approach Mr. M.C. Gupta, Security In-charge (Mob. No. 9899101932).
5. Some of our residents have converted their houses into paying guest accommodation. It is reported that the boys and girls in these guesthouses are roaming about in the parks during late hours. Even some outsiders also come and join them. This is a great security risk to the safety of the residents. We shall request such house owners to kindly have a proper check on them, as they are directly responsible if any untoward incident happens due to the behaviour of such persons. These things may be ensured before letting out your houses to such persons.

Residents are aware that unfortunate incidents are happening and we need to tighten the security further. Therefore co-operation from all the residents is very necessary. The security is a collective responsibility and we have all to be quite vigilant and careful about the surroundings around us. Residents are therefore requested to kindly co-operate so that our sector could be more secure and safe.
