#### **MEETING/CORRESPONDENCE WITH NOIDA AUTHORITY**

i. **HORTICULTURE**

A meeting was held with Dy. Director, Horticulture in which the following decisions were taken:

1. Watering in each park - fortnightly
2. Removal of Park garbage - Fortnightly
3. Purchase of 4 New Panels to facilitate watering the plants
4. Periodic visit by the officers from horticulture department to see that the parks are being maintained properly.

The meeting was attended by General Secretary - S.K. Sudan, accompanied by Executive member Mr. Anoop Bhati and Incharge horticulture Mr. I.D. Sharma.

ii. **STREET LIGHT**

The position of street light was very bad. We had been following up the case with the Noida Authority on telephone as well as in writing. A letter was sent to the Project Engineer enclosing therewith the list of the breakdown points on 12.4.2010.

iii. **REPAIR OF ROADS/SPEED BREAKERS**

The President Mr. K.L. Bansal has already spoken to CME, Mr. Goel. A meeting was also held emphasizing the urgency of the case. He has promised to do the needful urgently.

iv. **GAS PIPE LINE**

The job of laying Gas Pipe Line by IGL has already started - soon PNB connection will start. This will be a great relief to our residents. We shall request the residents to kindly give us their feed back in this regard.

v. **ELECTRIC WIRES IN 'C' BLOCK**

Complaints were being received from "C" Block residents about the damaged electric cables. There have been cases of fire and damage to parked vehicles. RWA took up the matter with the concerned authority on priority basis. Now this has been approved and cables will soon be replaced not only in 'C' Block but for all the blocks in the sector.

vi. **LOAD SHEDDING**

This is to inform our residents that load shedding will be there between 2.00pm to 4.00pm except Sunday during the month of May. Inconvenience caused to our residents due to this cut is very much regretted.

vii. **SECURITY**

On the advice of Police Gates No. 8, 9 & 11 were closed between 1.00pm to 4.00pm due to increase in chain snatching cases. We regret to inform that somebody in connivance with shopkeepers pressurized the Authority to reopen these gates thus causing security risk to the sector. This is not the first time. Earlier also RWA arranged for an enclosure around C Block market but this was demolished due to the pressure from shopkeepers. Gates closed for security were also got opened again due to the pressure from shopkeepers.

We are acquainting our residents with the above position so that they may know how some people get elected but remain defunct and non performers throughout the period of their tenure. They have time to minutely go through the contents of the circular to see how many times a particular word is used than to do some thing good for the sector for which our residents have elected them.

Security is sensitive matter and periodic appeals are made to our residents to kindly co-operate. Recently there have been some cases which need our urgent attention.

1. Group 4 Security Beat Patrol officer caught hold of 3 bikers near H-24. After a fight with them they ran away towards Aghapur side and could not be traced. They however left their Motor Cycles behind which were handed over to police.
2. There was an attempt to steal 800 Maruti Car of H-53 resident but Mr. R.K. Tiwari beat patrol officer foiled the attempt and informed the police.
3. There was a fire in E-32 Mr. Sharma beat patrol officer rang up the fire brigade Electricity department and got the fire extinguished.
4. Car thieves from C-Block Market were caught by G-4 Beat Officers and handed over to Police.

The above incidents show that there is an urgent need of the collective responsibility to prevent such incidents. Group 4 security has done a commendable job to prevent such incidents but the residents are also required to perform their duty towards security by rendering their co-operation and collectively fight this menace.

Some of the Residents insist to open Gates early in the morning. Gates are closed/opened for security reasons. Residents are requested to strict to the timings in the interest of security of the sector.
